### **Scholarship for American Senior Scholars and Artists – application deadline August 2, 2010**

The American Scholar program is an important component of the Fulbright Foundation's mission to bring outstanding U.S. Scholars from a wide variety of disciplines to Greek institutions of higher learning to promote cultural and educational ties between the two countries through scholarly interaction and ongoing collaboration.

Program Overview: The lecturing/research awards are for individuals with a Ph.D. or a terminal degree and 3-10 years of appropriate professional experience. Grants are intended for 3-4 months only for the first or second semester of the academic year 2011-12. The fall semester runs from October through January and the spring semester from February to June. A letter of invitation is recommended for all awards. The Fulbright Foundation in Greece will offer suggestions and propose institutions and contacts. English is sufficient for lecturing, however, knowledge of Greek is useful. ### **Scholarship for American Graduate Students - application deadline October 18, 2010**

For students who hold either a Bachelor's or Master's degree, for Ph.D. dissertation research purposes or for independent study. Applicants must secure an institutional affiliation in Greece. Grants are awarded for a period of nine months. Six-month grants will be considered for art projects and Ph.D. candidates. Grants are offered in all disciplines. Especially this year one grant is available in the following specialization areas: Byzantine Music, Classical Literature, Patristic Literature, Byzantine Art and Architecture, Iconography, "Mikrotechnia" (miniatures), New Testament Studies and Theology.
